- Some of our grant funding sources come with very strict guidelines for use and administration. It is very important for you to contact our office as soon as possible if you are unable to use your approved grant funds or your contact information changes. In some cases, a return of funds may be necessary if guidelines are not followed within the timeframe stipulated.
- Only 1 grant can be applied for and "open" with our organization at any given time, so it is important to use the funds and get your logs or follow up surveys turned in. You may then be eligible for another grant.
- The current granting period opens July 1st every year for CareLink and the Dementia Caregiver Respite Grant. The granting period will continue as long as funds are available.
- If you are a care providing service, when submitting invoices for payment, please attempt to invoice once <u>full</u> grant funding has been reached or submit <u>monthly</u> if possible. We want to do our best to control expenses for postage and supplies for both you and our organization.
